## ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION (PRIMARY AND SECONDARY)

## Non-U.S. Citizens

Primary Documents Accepted for Identification

- A valid foreign passport with an acceptable visa or resident alien card.
- Social Security number verification \* or letter from Social Security stating non-eligibility.
- Document from the "secondary" list authorizing presence in the U.S. for more than 160 days.
- A confirmation of employment letter from your employer can be helpful when opening bank accounts, obtaining a Social Security Number.

Additional Secondary Documents for Non-U.S. Citizens

- Valid I-94 arrival/departure record issued by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.
- Employment authorization document with valid Social Security card.
- Valid visa (with supporting documents) authorizing presence in the United States for a period exceeding 160 days.
- Original I-797 (notice of action) issued by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, showing approval of change of status or extension of stay.
- Original I-797 (notice of action) issued by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, evidencing timely filing of an extension petition.
- International Driver's License.

## Star-ID

Individuals (citizens and non-citizens) may apply for a STAR-ID from the Department of Motor Vehicles. The designation may be added to your Alabama driver's license, or you may request a non-driver's STAR-ID. This card is authorized for use as identification for official federal government purposes, such as boarding commercial aircraft and entering certain regulated federal facilities, or for other purposes as a driver's license would be (for proof of age when purchasing alcohol, for instance).

- Valid foreign passport with valid U.S. immigration document.

- Professional license issued by a state or federal agency.

  - Certified letter from school;
