

Day 1: Sunday, April 3, 2016 Overnight Flight An overnight flight transports you to a country of stunning landscapes, lively cities, stirring history plus distinct myths and stories.

Day 2: Monday, April 4, 2016 Glasgow, Scotland - Tour Begins Your tour opens in Glasgow. Tonight, meet your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3: Tuesday, April 5, 2016
Glasgow - Ballachulish Begin your day with a cruise on famed Loch Lomond, the largest lake in the United Kingdom. Enjoy time at leisure in the charming town of Callander before visiting one of Scotland's renowned whisky distilleries. Taste and see for yourself why Highland malt whisky is considered the world's finest. Marvel at the beauty of the Highlands as we make our way through Glencoe and Rannoch Moor before arriving at your hotel situated on lovely Loch Linnhe. (B, D)

Day 4: Wednesday, April 6, 2016 Ballachulish - Isle of Skye -

Ballachulish Take a stunning drive

along the "Road to the Isles" and over

the Skye Bridge to the legendary Isle of Skye, also known in poetry and song as Eilean a' Cheò (The Misty Isle). Enjoy dramatic views of the Cuillin Hills. Then, visit Armadale Castle & Gardens* and the Museum of the Isles to learn about island life and the history of Skye. Conclude your visit with views of the isle from yet another vantage point during a ferry crossing back to the mainland. Returning to Ballachulish, see Glenfinnan where Bonnie Prince Charlie rallied the clansmen for battle during the 1745 Jacobite Rebellion. (B, D)

Day 5: Thursday, April 7, 2016 Ballachulish - Loch Ness - Thurso

Today, enjoy stunning and unspoiled landscapes as you journey further into the Highlands. Take in the panorama of Loch Ness, one of Britain's most scenic bodies of water. Keep your





eyes open - you never know when Nessie will appear! **Soak up the aweinspiring view at the striking ruins of Urquhart Castle.** Travel through the Great Glen, famous for its many lochs (lakes). Your day concludes in Thurso. (B, D)

Day 6: Friday, April 8, 2016 Thurso -Orkney Islands - Thurso A day of adventure awaits as you voyage by ferry to the Orkney Islands, for many years a Viking stronghold off the coast of Scotland. On the crossing you'll see abundant bird life and, if you are very lucky, porpoises and seals. A local guide introduces this magical place that very few visitors to Scotland get to experience. Visit Skara Brae where you will discover the remains of a Neolithic village built at the same time as the Great Pyramid in Egypt. Next, pass the prehistoric Ring of Brodgar, reported to be older than Stonehenge. Visit the town of Viking Kirkwall before returning to the mainland. (B)

Day 7: Saturday, April 9, 2016 Thurso - Inverness Today you will visit the Culloden Battlefield. On this spot in April 1746, a half-hour battle changed

the course of history. We also stop at the majestic Dunrobin Castle** which dates back to the 1300s. Experience a fascinating falconry display in the formal gardens overlooking the North Sea. Soak in the breathtaking views as you drive along the windswept cliffs of Scotland's east coast. Continue to Inverness, "Capital of the Highlands," for your overnight stay. (*B*, *D*)

Day 8: Sunday, April 10, 2016 Inverness - Pitlochry - St. Andrews -Edinburgh As we depart the rugged Highlands, pause to watch a traditional farmer working his sheep dogs. You will be amazed by their skill and enthusiasm! Next, stop at Pitlochry, a vibrant Victorian town. Discover its Old World appeal as you explore this popular resort town on your own. Travel to St. Andrews, the beautiful town in the Kingdom of Fife that gave the world the game of golf, to see the Royal and Ancient Clubhouse and the famous Old Course. End your day in Scotland's capital city of Edinburgh. (B)

Day 9: Monday, April 11, 2016 Edinburgh Come to know this regal city on a locally-guided tour that



includes Edinburgh Castle, home of the Scottish Crown Jewels, and the Palace of Holyroodhouse***, the Queen's official residence in Edinburgh and former home of Mary, Queen of Scots. This afternoon, enjoy free time to independently explore the city. Finally, toast the end to a wonderful trip with a farewell dinner*** complete with traditional Scottish entertainment. (B, D)

Day 10: Tuesday, April 12, 2016 Edinburgh - Tour Ends Your tour of Scotland comes to a close today. (B)

Experience It! The Orkney Islands & Skara Brae

Off the coast of Northern Scotland 10 miles from Duncansby Head in Caithness lies a stunning archipelago comprised of 70 islands which are famously called the Orkney Islands. This breathtaking spot off the beaten path is waiting for your discovery. Voyage by ferry to the islands, keeping an eye out for an abundance of bird life, as well as porpoises and seals. A local guide reveals its Viking heritage and introduces you to the wonders around you. To make the visit even more wonderful, visit Skara Brae and find the remains of a Neolithic village built at the same time as the Great Pyramid in Egypt. It's a journey through history – a true highlight of your tour to fascinating Scotland.

Please Note:

To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing Collette airfare with your tour. - *Armadale Castle and Gardens is open from April to October. On other dates a visit to Eilean Donan Castle will be substituted.
- **Dunrobin Castle is open from April to October. When it is closed you will visit Fort George or similar.
- ***The Palace of Holyroodhouse may occasionally be closed when the Queen is in residence or for official state functions.

****During the off season (November 1 - March 31), alternative dinner arrangements will be made at a local pub.

This tour includes moderate physical activity. The itinerary blends some longer days with shorter days and more leisure time. Walking tours, as well as walking slightly longer distances, up stairs or on uneven walking surfaces should be expected.
