# TOUR AGENDA – CHINA WITH TERRACOTTA WARRIORS

### Day 1 - Oct. 1 Los Angeles/Beijing

Check in at Los Angeles International Airport for an early morning flight CA984 by 1:40am to Beijing. Your adventure begins as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner. Cross the International Dateline.

# Day 2 – Oct. 2 Beijing (Beijing Marriott City Wall/5 star, No.7 Jian Guo Men South Ave. Dong Cheng District, Tel: 0086-10-58118888)

Arrive in Beijing, the Capital of China at 5:30am. You will be met by your local tour guide at the airport. Visit the Tian An Men Square, the largest square in the world, and the Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City, home of 24 emperors with a total space of 9,999 rooms. After lunch be transferred to the hotel for a rest.

### Day 3 – Oct. 3 Beijing

Visit the 2008 Beijing Olympic venues for the outside views of National Stadium the Bird's Nest and the National Aquatic Center. Continue the tour to the Great Wall. En route visit the Jade Factory. The Great Wall, the 4,000- mile long and 2,000 years old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by naked eye from the moon. Visit one of the Ming tombs, one of 13 Ming Emperors' Tombs is fully excavated and open for exploration. Have a business meeting with local government.

## Day 4 – Oct. 4 Beijing

Visit the Temple of Heaven, built in 1420 A.D., where the emperors prayed to the heaven for a good harvest. Visit the Pearl Market. The city tour continues with the Summer Palace, known

for many significance such as the Long Corridor with painted gallery, Kunming Lake and Longevity Hill, Seventeen- Arch Bridge and Marble Boat. Peking Roast Duck dinner is arranged.

# Day 5 – Oct. 5 Beijing/Xi'an (Golden Flower Hotel/5 star, 8 Changle Road West, Tel: 0086-29-83232981)

Morning flight to Xi'an HU7137 7:50am/9:50am. Sightseeing to the Big Wild Goose Pagoda. Visit the Chinese Lacquer Ware Workshop. Evening entertainment of a Tang Style Dancing Show.

#### Day 6 – Oct. 6 Xi'an

In the morning bus excursion to the Terra-Cotta Warriors at the Tomb of the First Emperor of Qin Dynasty. En route visit the Xian Art Ceramic & Terra Cotta Factory. On the way back, visit the Ancient City Wall and Banpo Museum, a preserved pre-historical cavemen site.

# Day 7 – Oct. 7 Xi'an/Shanghai (Renaissance Shanghai Putuo Hotel/5 star, No.50 Tongchuan Road, Putuo District, Tel: 0086-21-22195888)

Morning flight to Shanghai CA1831 7:30am/9:40am, then take a bus riding to Suzhou. Afternoon sightseeing to the Tiger Hill.

### Day 8 - Oct. 8 Shanghai

The Bund, a famous waterfront park. Visit the Shanghai Silk Rug Factory. Afternoon enjoy the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and overarching trees. Free time exploration of the old town bazaar. Visit the Pudong District.
