Day 1: USA - Milan, Italy

Today, depart the U.S. on an international flight to Italy. (in-flight meals)

Day 2: Milan

Day 3: Como

Today, enjoy a visit to Lake Como and three famous villas: Villa Carlotta and the botanical garden, Villa Balbianello and Villa Melzi. Lake Como, is a jewel-like oasis of tranquility, a magical combination of lush Mediterranean foliage and snowy alpine peaks. Wooded mountain slopes protect the lake from extremes of temperature. Popular since Roman times, Lake Como is a top romantic travel destination and a great spot for photography. Later in the day take a short visit of the town Como.
