

HIGHLIGHTS & PORTS

DAY 1 (Oct 17): Departure from USA

Sit back and relax on your overnight flight. (In-flight meals)

DAY 2 (Oct 18): Switzerland

Arrive today in Switzerland, known for its chocolate, cheese, watches and picturesque landscapes. Transfer for your hotel for the evening and enjoy a Welcome drink with the group.

DAY 3 (Oct 19): Basel

Begin your journey to Basel, Switzerland's vibrant third-largest city. This afternoon, board your elegant AMADEUS vessel and meet your fellow travelers over a Welcome

Cocktail and Dinner. Your floating hotel sets sail later this afternoon. (B,D)

Day 4 (Oct 20): Strasbourg

Overnight, your ship sails into
France's Alsace region, docking in
charming Strasbourg. On today's
included discovery tour, enjoy a short
coach ride through the city followed
by a guided walk of the historic
old town, with highlights such as
the famous Straßburger Münster
Cathedral*, half-timbered houses,
and medieval Petite France. A scenic
boat cruise along the River Ill reveals
more treasures, including the Ponts
Couverts, Palais de Rohan, and the
Council of Europe. (B,L,D)

Day 5 (Oct 21): Speyer - Mannheim

Arrive in Speyer, once a city of great influence during the Holy Roman Empire. Explore its Imperial Cathedral and taste the famous Speyer pretzel on an OPTIONAL walking tour. After lunch, cruise to Mannheim, the gateway to Heidelberg. On your included tour, discover this romantic university town with its baroque Old Town and magnificent castle ruins. Visit the red sandstone castle and gardens, take in panoramic views from the Grand Terrace, and stroll past landmarks such as the Karl-Theodor Bridge, the Church of the Holy Spirit, and the

town hall before rejoining your ship later that evening. (B,L,D)

Day 6 (Oct 22): Mannheim -Ruedesheim - Koblenz

This morning, explore the charming wine town of Rüdesheim. Ride the Winzerexpress train to the Siegfried Mechanical Music Cabinet Museum for a fascinating look at historical self-playing instruments, then stroll the lively Drosselgasse with its wine houses and garden taverns. Discover more of the old town, including the Eagle Tower and 15th-century fortifications, or opt for a vineyard tour with tastings. At lunchtime, cruise through the breathtaking Upper Middle Rhine Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, passing castles, vineyards, and the legendary Lorelei Rock. Arrive in Koblenz, one of Germany's oldest towns, where you may enjoy an OPTIONAL walking tour or ride the cable car up to Ehrenbreitstein Fortress for panoramic views. (B,L,D)

Day 7 (Oct 23): Koblenz - Cochem

This morning, cruise the scenic Moselle River to fairytale Cochem, framed by vineyards and forested hills. On your included walking tour, wander the narrow streets of the old town before visiting the dramatic Reichsburg Castle, perched high above the valley. Explore its

grand halls filled with Renaissance and Baroque treasures and take in breathtaking views of the Moselle below. Learn how the Ravené family preserved the castle before gifting it to the town, ensuring its history could be shared with future generations. Afterward, sample the town's cozy wine culture on your own, before returning to your ship for dinner as you sail toward Cologne. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 (Oct 24): Cologne

Discover Cologne, a vibrant city with over 2,000 years of history. On your guided walking tour, explore the Gothic Cologne Cathedral*, Germany's most visited landmark, before strolling through the narrow cobbled streets and lively squares of the Old Town. Learn how Cologne blends its ancient Roman roots with modern life as you pass the Alter Markt and Heumarkt. Conclude your tour with a taste of the city's signature Kölsch beer, beloved throughout the Rhineland. After lunch, relax on board as your ship sails onward. (*Cathedral visit subject to opening hours and Holy Mass schedule.) (B,L,D)

Day 9 (Oct 25): Amsterdam

Wake up in Amsterdam, the lively Dutch capital. Explore its iconic canals on an **OPTIONAL** boat tour or stroll the city at your leisure. In the afternoon, join an **OPTIONAL** journey to the Waterland countryside, visiting the quaint villages of Volendam and Edam for a traditional Dutch cheese tasting. Your ship remains docked overnight in Amsterdam. (B,L,D)

Day 10 (Oct 26): Amsterdam

After breakfast depart our floating home for the airport or join our 3-night post tour to Amsterdam to explore the capital of the Netherlands even further! (B)
