### **Teresa Williamson Named 2026 Mobile Chamber Chairman of the Board**

**MOBILE, Ala.** – The Mobile Chamber has named Teresa Williamson, president of Roberts Brothers, Inc., as its 2026 Chairman of the Board. Williamson expressed her enthusiasm for the year ahead and emphasized the importance of collaboration among business and community leaders.

“For 190 years, the Mobile Chamber has been a cornerstone of our community, a driving force for economic development, a champion for businesses of all sizes and an advocate for progress that benefits us all,” Williamson said. “This year, we’ll focus on continuing the tremendous momentum we’ve built, working alongside our new mayor and ensuring our members have the advocacy, resources and connections they need to succeed. Together, we have the power to create meaningful, lasting change for the people and families who call Mobile home.”

Williamson was named president of Roberts Brothers, Inc. in 2022, becoming the first person outside the Roberts family to lead the historic Mobile real estate brand. She joined the company in 2009 as a sales associate before purchasing the Roberts Brothers Saraland franchise three years later. She later served as general manager and managing broker of Roberts Brothers West, where she helped elevate the office to record success.

Today, she oversees more than 300 real estate professionals across seven offices.
