

## MEMBER DATA SHARING

Section 20.1 General. The Chamber shall collect, maintain, and share member data with other Chamber members, third-party partners, and sponsors, where such sharing aligns with the Chamber's mission and facilitating growth opportunities.

Section 20.2 Member Consent. By becoming a member of the Chamber, each member consents to the sharing of their business-related data with other members for the purpose of promoting business opportunities, collaboration, and networking. However, each member retains the right to limit or restrict the sharing of specific data

Section 20.3 Opt-Out. Members will be provided with the option to opt-out of data sharing during the membership registration process or at any time thereafter. Members who choose to opt-out will not have their data shared, except for essential communications or events related to Chamber functions.

Section 20.4 Sensitive Data. The Chamber will not share personal or sensitive data (such as financial information, personal addresses, or proprietary business information) without explicit, written consent from the member.

Section 20.5 Data Accuracy. Members are responsible for ensuring that the information they provide to the Chamber is accurate and up to date.

Section 20.6 Category of Shared Data. The Chamber may share the following member information:

- Company name
- Member's name and job title
- Business contact information (phone number, email, website, address)
- Industry or sector of operation
- Business services/products offered
- Images or video taken by the Chamber
- Images or video submitted by a member to the Chamber
